

CareRide Program

Having trouble finding a ride to a medical appointment?

CareRide is a subsidized transportation service for **non-emergency medical appointments**, offered by Elder Services of the Merrimack Valley and North Shore, for anyone 65 plus who resides in the **Greater Lowell area**. CareRide provides on-demand transportation to doctors' appointments and health and wellness programs when no other transportation options are available. The program uses Lyft and handicap-accessible vans to provide transportation, depending on the consumers need.

The program is referral-based and all referrals for CareRide services are processed by the Program Coordinator.
